DCO Rules and Regulations

DANCE CENTERS OF ORLANDO is insistent on maintaining a SAFE, CLEAN, COMFORTABLE environment for EVERYONE. Please discuss these rules with your child so they understand what is expected of them.

No gum, candy, drinks (with the exception of water) food, smoking or cell phones are allowed in our studios AT ANY TIME. There is both a water cooler and a water machine where you or your child can obtain water. If you are using a water bottle, please make sure you mark your name on it and dispose of it when you are done. Healthy snacks are available for consumption in the break room only.

You may eat or drink these items or use your cell phone in the break room, front office, lobby, dressing room or outside the building only.

NO RUNNING inside DCO studios, which includes the break room, lobby, dressing rooms or offices.

Dance shoes are meant to be worn inside our building, NOT IN THE STREET. Conversely, NO STREET SHOES ARE TO BE WORN IN ANY OF THE DANCE STUDIOS. Our studio flooring system is the highest quality and we appreciate you helping us to keep it protected. By changing your shoes before you leave our building, you also assure that you will not bring in particles of sand and dirt the=2 Onext time you enter the studio.

TAP SHOE RULE: We ask that our students not practice tap outside of the 3 studios. It is disturbing to classes going on inside studios, they can be damaging to other floors, and most importantly IT IS DANGEROUS FOR YOUR CHILD.

On rainy days please change your shoes in the lobby.

Please do not bring expensive items, such as I pods, Mp3Players, etc. to DCO. Too often items are not marked properly, and they have a way of going lost.

Students are required to pick up after themselves and to leave break rooms, waiting areas, and restrooms neat and orderly. We certainly don't ask them to clean, just to pick up after themselves.

Students should arrive no later than 5 minutes prior to their scheduled class time. It is very important not to be late to class! If a student is unable to attend their scheduled class time, please call the office at 407.340.6890

Although we have the best soundproofing money can buy, because of doors that open and close our studios and voice rooms cannot be totally soundproof. Please keep the noise level down in the break room and main office areas as we don't want anyone's classes being disturbed.
